is a Georgia 501c3 nonprofit that helps veterans in the Atlanta area transition back to civilian life; no matter how long ago they left military service.

The bulk of our work involves assisting at-risk, and homeless veterans discover, and secure resources that will help them either find a home, or keep the one they have; as well as providing support, clothing, and supplies to the homeless community at-large.

We also field calls from the VA, and other nonprofits to help find, or provide shelter to veterans with special needs, or with children that have special needs because even though these are some of our soldiers that are most in need, shelters may not be able to accommodate their situation.

With the help of our communities, we assist & provide for those in desperate need of the essentials for their survival, and engage those we help to discover pathways for them to prosper.

Our intent is to mitigate the statistical probabilities of recurring poverty, dependency & homelessness through mentorship, education, and resource based programs.

We realize these intentions through community outreach, a small network of trusted 3rd parties, and people like you that share our goal of leaving no one behind.

In our first year as a 501c3 charity, we raised over \$28,000. Blessed with those donations, and grants, we were able to:

- **Provide** homeless veterans, and their families, with temporary housing, transportation, and direct assistance during their search for a place to call home.
- **Purchase** dependable vehicles for veterans who had lost their transportation
- **Enable** veterans families in our care to purchase their own groceries with a grant from Kroger Foods.
- **Empower** veterans with grants for emergency expenses.
- **Share** a meal with over 100 individual veterans
- Provision and install a flat-top outdoor gas grill for a local homeless shelter
- Organize, and Facilitate the movement of a shipment of hygiene supplies from the local volunteer community Stand Up for Stand Down to the US Virgin Islands with the assistance from Newborn United Methodist Church.
